Open Doors: Betsy Kolkea



Eritrea is fourth on Open Doors' World Watch List and is known as 'the North Korea of Africa'. Courageous Christians who gather to meet risk raids, fines and long term imprisonment in awful conditions.

In January over 30 Eritrean Christians and their children were arrested when celebrating the first birthday of one of their children. Non believers were sent home.

The government watches everyone and promotes a stigma against Christians. It's estimated over 1,000 Christians are currently in prison having been charged with no crime. Female prisoners are subjected to gender based violence.

Let's pray for each of these courageous brothers and sisters. **Let's pray** for courage (Philippians 1.20), and for a deep awareness of our great Comforter with them.
