Whilst the eyes of the world are understandably on conflicts in Europe and the Middle East, an escalating conflict between M23 rebels and Congolese forces in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) has caused hundreds of thousands of people to flee for their lives. The Bishop of Goma is calling on Christians worldwide **to pray for** a miracle of peace for a nation weary of violent conflict. Prior to the most recent hostilities there had been significant church growth in the area.

Pray for new Christians to hold fast to Jesus and for pastors and church leaders to know how to encourage them.

Pray too for protection from violence and disease for the civilian population and that peaceful and diplomatic means will be found to end the conflict.

Open Doors: Betsy Kolkea



India has risen from 28 to 11 in the Open Doors World Watch List in the past ten years. Since the BJP party came to power in 2014, Hindu extremists have grown stronger, and the persecution of Christians (and those of any faith other than Hinduism) has increased.

Churches are burned, Pastors has been arrested and have gone missing, violent attacks are not uncommon on Christians. Persecution can also be more subtle, with false accusations raised, churches being closed down, and economic hardship experienced by Christians who are discriminated against in education and employment.

Let's stop and think about each of those elements of persecution. Let's individually consider what our own response would be. Let's be grateful that these Indian brothers and sisters are being courageous to stand firm, and that they are being counted worthy to share with Christ in his suffering and rejection. Let's uphold them this month in prayer, mindful that when one part of the Church suffers, all the parts suffer with it. (1 Cor: 12:26)
